1.

You get a Danish residence document , "opholdsdokument", by adressing Statsforvaltningen in Copenhagen

You have to show up personally and bring along :

- Passport
- documentation for your stay in DK , e.g. a letter from your educational institution
- your application for the residence document (can be downloaded from the web-site: www.statsforvaltningen.dk)

You then show the residence document, "opholdsdokument", at your municipality/ "kommune", where you get the CPR-number and a social security card .
